Sub: Issue of Sale Certificate and delivery of possession in favour of the purchaser(s) of immovable properties purchased through public auction under the Odisha Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 2011.

Consequent upon the orders passed by the Designated Court as per the provision of sub-section (6) of Section 9 of the Odisha Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 2011 declaring the ad-interim orders of attachment of properties of a Financial Establishment absolute.

And consequent upon the sale of the attached properties by the Additional District Magistrate and Competent Authority concerned following the procedures laid down by the Government vide Resolution No.18158/F dated 26.10.2015 read with sub-rule (4) of Rule 7 of the Odisha Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Rules, 2013 through public auction, will issue Sale Certificate and deliver the physical possession of the properties to the successful auction purchaser(s).

After careful consideration of the issues with regard to the mode of transferring the right, title and possession of the properties to the respective successful auction purchaser(s), the Government have been pleased to decide that:-

- the Additional District Magistrate and Competent Authority concerned shall issue Sale Certificate in favour of the successful auction purchaser(s) as per the proforma (Annexure-I) attached hereto after realisation of the entire auction value,
- the registration of Sale Certificate is exempted in view of the provision under clause (xii) of sub-section (2) of section 17 of the Registration Act, 1908,
- (iii) the Additional District Magistrate and Competent Authority shall issue a notice to the auction purchaser(s) to deposit requisite Stamp papers worth 5% of the auctioned amount as stamp duty, and in case the auction purchaser is a woman the same shall be 4% within 21 days, in accordance with Article 18 read with Article 23 of the Schedule-I of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899,

(iv) the Sale Certificate shall be prepared in triplicate by the Additional District Magistrate and Competent Authority mentioning the case in which orders for sale of the property was passed by the Designated Court, the date of

auction and other details required under law,

(v) the original Sale Certificate shall be prepared on Stamp Papers furnished by the auction purchaser(s) by the Additional District Magistrate and Competent Authority within 10 days of receipt of the Stamp Papers and shall be sealed and signed by the Additional District Magistrate and Competent Authority and the auction purchaser(s). The other two copies shall be xeroxed from the original Sale Certificate and be duly authenticated by the concerned Additional District Magistrate and Competent Authority,

(vi) the original Sale Certificate prepared on the stamp paper is to be handed over to the purchaser(s) for the purpose of updating the land records. Out of the remaining two copies, one is to be kept in the case record and other is to be sent to the Registering Authority concerned for maintaining Book-1 as required under sub-section (2) of section 89 of the Registration Act, 1908.
